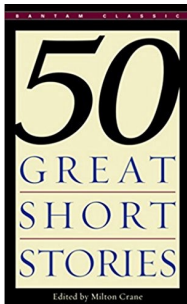
1. *History's Greatest Speeches*, Edited by James Daley  
Speech writing, analysis, syntax



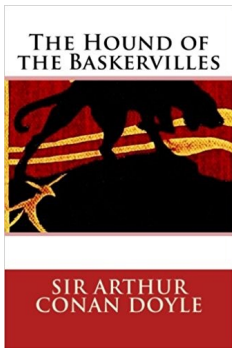
2. *The Scarlet Letter* by Nathaniel Hawthorne (Abeka Book Publishing)

Textual analysis, symbolism, essay writing

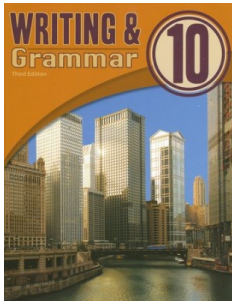


4. *50 Great Short Stories* by Milton Crane
