



Class Name: Digital Photography 2
Spring 2019

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Grade level: 9th-12th

Description: This course will help students develop an understanding of the technical and aesthetic foundations of color photography with a DSLR Digital Camera. Adobe Photoshop and Lightroom will be used to edit photographs and enhance the end product.

Students will learn how to use their digital camera modes and settings, aperture, shutter speed, ISO, white balance, metering, lense & filter use, color balance & color theory, and creative composition. We will not be using automatic settings, so the camera must have Manual mode.

We will use natural light for photography sessions during class time and for homework assignments. The students will be given each photography assignment to complete outside of class hours, they will bring their photographic work to class on a flash drive, each student will need their own laptop to work on, preferably with Adobe Cloud Software with Photoshop and Lightroom editing programs. During the semester we will schedule photographic field trip outside of class hours as a group destination to be determined. **This is a 1 semester class.**

Prerequisites: Basic knowledge of Digital Camera

Supplies required: Students must have their own digital camera, flash drives 4to 8 GB, memory card adapter, Camera bag, notebook, Laptop, Adobe Photoshop & Lightroom program if possible.
