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Grade Level: 7th-12th

Course Description: Drama is a class where students will learn by doing, not only in the technical aspects, but the creative as well. Technical aspects will include how to audition, speak and express oneself without anxiety in front of an audience, basic music theory and vocal instruction, and movement for the stage. Creative aspects will include interpretation of dramatic material through individual gifts and working together as a group to present various themes and ideas. Students will also participate in set, costume, and lighting design, prop construction. The first semester will include a brief history of the theatre and weekly exercises in performance art to prepare for the end of the year musical production. Casting for the production will be by audition only at the end of the first semester during class. Parent volunteers will be needed for the front and back of the house during dress rehearsals and performance. **COME HAVE SOME FUN WHILE LEARNING!**
