Course Description: This is a two semester course designed to: teach students to recognize different kinds of fallacies and common errors in reasoning; build critical thinking skills; and equip students with the necessary tools for answering common questions they may encounter about God, Jesus, the Bible, and their faith.

In the fall, our primary resources will be "The Fallacy Detective" and "Don't Check Your Brains at the Door." In class, we will spend the majority of our time discussing the lessons from both of these books. Additionally, we will be watching "The New Answers" DVDs. These DVDs cover 40 of the most asked questions from "The New Answers" books.

In the spring, we will use "The Thinking Toolbox" and lots of logic games as our primary resources. This class will be very hands on. We will learn to distinguish an argument from a fight, play lots of critical thinking games, conduct a science experiment, and even complete individual projects and presentations as a fun way to end our year.
