**Course Description:** Saxon 8/7 textbook reviews arithmetic calculation, measurements, geometry and other skills, and introduces pre-algebra, ratios, probability and statistics. Students will learn about adding/subtracting/multiplying fractions, equivalent fractions, the metric system, repeating decimals, scientific notation, Pi, graphing inequalities, multiplying algebraic terms, the Pythagorean Theorem, the slope-intercept form of linear equations, and more.

Daily lessons include a facts practice sheets located in the workbook listed below, mental math and problem solving exercises at the beginning of each lesson in the textbook, vocabulary words, and a daily problem set where students will practice all the skills they have learned. Students can expect about 30-45 minutes of homework daily. It is highly recommended that parents grade the homework and student correct their errors daily. This prevents students from practicing incorrect skills for the whole week. This also allows our class time to be spent on instruction of new material.
