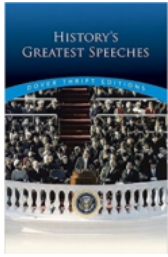

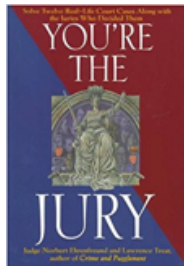

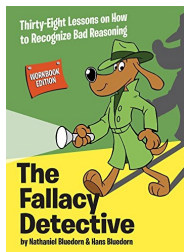
1. *History's Greatest Speeches*, edited by James Daley
