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Grade Level: 5th-8th

Course Description: This middle school history study begins around 29 A.D with the first followers of Jesus, continuing through the early church and into the Middle Ages through 1456 A.D. We'll learn about Paul's missionary journeys, Pompeii, Attila the Hun, the Dark Ages, King Arthur & the Knights of the Round Table, vikings, Leif Ericsson, the Crusades and more! The goal is to make learning history enjoyable for the student through interesting weekly lessons and interactive class activities. We will be creating notebook timelines, memory cards, location maps but also recalling information through fun in class games like Jeopardy!
