**Course Description:** Saxon 7/6 textbook introduces functions and coordinate graphing, integers, exponential expressions, and prime factorization. Students will learn about the order of operations, number lines, decimal place value, how to find the percent of a number, how to round decimal numbers, attributes of geometric solids, and more. The foundation provided in this course will prepare students for Pre-Algebra and beyond.

**What to Expect:** Daily lessons include a facts practice sheets located in the workbook listed below, mental math and problem solving exercises at the beginning of each lesson in the textbook, vocabulary words, and a daily problem set where students will practice all the skills they have learned. Students can expect about 45 minutes of homework daily. **Parents should grade the homework and have their student correct their errors daily. The best learning takes place when we correct our errors. This is a crucial step to gaining a full understanding of the material.** In addition to class instructional time, I provide videos with extra practice problems for the student to view online at SchoolTube. **Access to the internet and a SchoolTube account will be required.** Please feel free to email or text me any additional questions during the week.
