Grade Level: 5th-12th

Course Description: This class is designed to help students foster their love for the performing arts (including acting, singing and dancing) through fun and engaging activities that will help develop and strengthen fundamental skills necessary for stage productions.

The following will be covered over the course of the year:

- * Team building and leadership exercises
 - * Character development – Making a character complete and real
 - * Improvisation – Creating without preparing
 - * Voice – Warm-ups & Techniques for better articulation and projection
 - * Musicality – How to incorporate song and dance to enhance a production
 - * Stage – Movement & Blocking for performers
 - * Stage – Set design and props for production
 - * Costuming & Stage Make-up
- * Brief histories of the different performing art types (Actors, Singers, and Dancers) and the types of careers these performers can have.

There will be (2) two yearly productions: Fall Semester/Spring Semester

Supplies Required: 2" binder (any color) with clearview cover. Students will also need to come up with their own costume for each production based on the character they get to play.
