

Class Name: Geometry Block 1 (9:00-9:55) Fall & Spring 2024-25

Grade Level: 10th-12th

Course Description: This course introduces students to a balanced study of geometric theorems and real-life applications. Students will study formal definitions, reasoning, congruence, similarity, constructions, two- and three-dimensional figures, coordinate geometry, transformations, and trigonometry. Several historical fiction accounts introduce students to key figures in mathematical history and provide opportunities for biblical worldview shaping, while "Geometry Around Us" sections highlight real-life applications of geometry.
