Course Description: This theme-based writing curriculum offers a full year of instruction. Students will work through IEW Units 1-7 as they learn to take notes, retell narrative stories, summarize references, write from pictures, and compose their own fables, myths and fairy tales. They will learn a variety of stylistic techniques to incorporate in their writing including adjectives, verbs, adverbs, clauses and sentence openers. We will also work on vocabulary that goes along with the lesson each week.

Prerequisites: The ability to write cohesive sentences and able to read on a 5th grade reading level.
