**Course Description:** This class is equivalent to 2.0 credits.

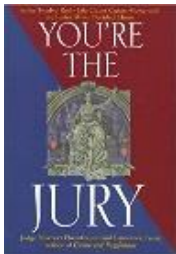
It covers all Speech and Debate requirements with an English option for 2.0 credits (1.0 Speech and 1.0 Debate)

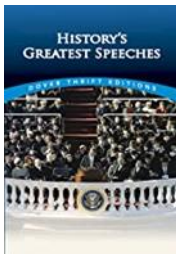

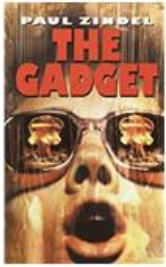

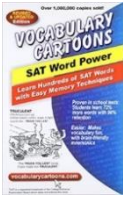
