Grade Levels: Grades 5-12

Class Description: I Peter 3:15 "but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect."

This class focuses on equipping the student to walk out of the class with an unshakeable and Biblical Worldview. All work for this class is done during class hours - there is no homework. Students build their cases against false ideologies found in the six major worldviews known throughout mankind's history. Students work with others in the class and parents are able to view their student's progress through journal entries completed each week in class.
