Grade Levels: Grades 5-6

**Class Description:** IEW Level A -Writing Course: Fables, Myths and Fairy Tales This theme-based writing curriculum offers a full year of instruction. Students will work through IEW Units 1-7 as they learn to take notes, retell narrative stories, summarize references, write from pictures, and compose their own fables, myths and fairy tales. They will learn a variety of stylistic techniques to incorporate in their writing including adjectives, verbs, adverbs, clauses and sentence openers. We will also work on vocabulary that goes along with the lesson each week. This class can be tiered to meet your needs. This would include creative reading at home, and/or accelerated material information. Homework is dependent upon the speed of reading the novels. Not expected to exceed 2 ½ hours per week.

**Prerequisites:** Ability to write cohesive sentences and be able to read on a 5th grade reading level.
