Class Name: World History

Grade levels: 9-12

Class Description: The student will read and learn about our world's history from Creation to the 21st Century through a Biblical worldview. The course includes a Nations Project in the first semester, a geography/map skills project in the second semester, and discussing civilizations around the world. Students can expect to spend 30-45 mins a day on homework & chapter reading. Use of Google Classroom for assignments.
